**Why is an annual CRS Recertification required?**

- Verify continued implementation of Activities.
- A way to keep contact information current
- Helps new CRS Coordinators see what Activities they are credited for
- IS NOT a FEMA Community Assistance Visits (CAVs) or FEMA Community Assistance Contacts (CACs)





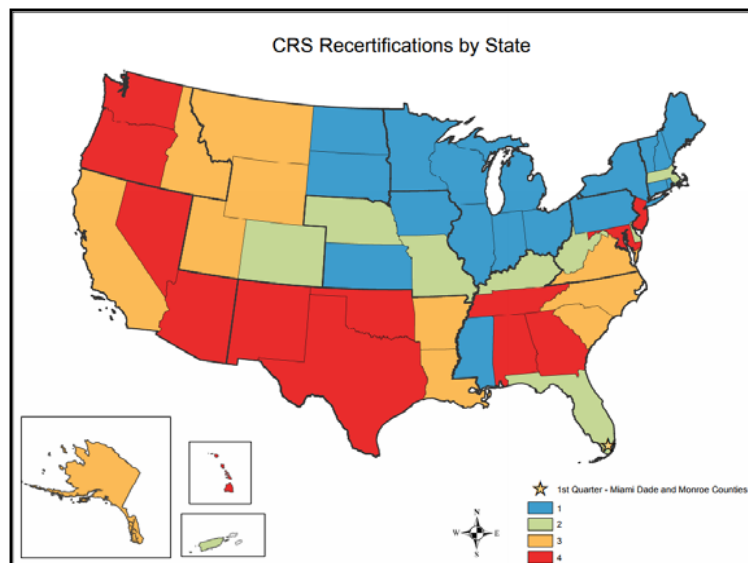

## Preparing an Annual Recertification

### New Central Review process:

1. What? Why?
  - ALL recertifications and EC reviews now handled by 3 Resource Specialists; consistency
  - Free up time for ISO/CRS Specialists
2. Recertifications staggered quarterly
  - A. **Tried to keep # of communities and # of ECs even**
  - B. Keep CRS Specialist's territories together
  - C. Keep FEMA Regions together
  - D. Geographic considerations (down time?)
  - E. Hurricane Season
